BULLETIN TO ALL MEMBERS:

RE: Letters of Declination for Excess Physician's
and Surgeon's Malpractice Insurance when the
primary carrier is the Medical Protective
Company, of Fort Wayne, Indiana

The Stamping Office and Contact Committee at its meeting held on February 23, 1955, requested this office to advise the members that in the future when writing excess Physician's and Surgeon's Malpractice insurance over the Medical Protective Company of Fort Wayne, Indiana, where the primary insurance is in limits of \$2,500/7,500 or \$5/15,000 it will no longer be necessary to secure a Letter of Declination from this Company.

The Letter of Declination from the Medical Protective Company is not necessary as the Stamping Office has a letter stating that the above limits are the limits at which it is now writing Physician's and Surgeon's Malpractice insurance.
