Workmen's Compensation Insurance.

Gentlemen:

Following our recent telephone conversations we have further reviewed the questions asked as to whether the increase in the Deductible for excess workmen's compensation insurance to \$21,000, effective October 1, 1959, applies to policies with renewal dates after said October 1, but which had been sent out by the surplus line broker prior to such date.

It is our conclusion that the amended requirements of Rule XV, of the California Workmen's Compensation Insurance Wanual, are applicable to all excess workmen's compensation insurance policies with a renewal date on or after October 1, 1959.

Section 4 of Rule III of said Manual requires the policy to contain a provision binding the employer to any changes in rates required by later promulgations of the Insurance Commissioner.

Section 6 of Rule I specifically provides that all amendments to the Manual shall be applied as of the first "normal anniversary rating date" following the promulgation of the amendment.

Section 2 of Rule VII of the Manual defines the term "normal anniversary rating date" to be the expiration date of the existing policy except under certain circumstances explained in said Manual.

In view of the foregoing of the Addition is inescapable that any excess workmen's compensation policy effective on or after October 1, 1959 must contain the \$21,000 Deductibe irrespective of when the renewal policy may have been sent to the producing agent or broker, or to the insured.
