BULLETIN TO ALL MEMBERS:

RE: EXCESS FIDELITY COVERAGE WRITTEN IN A NON-ADMITTED INSURER UNDER THE RULE ON PAGE 74 OF THE SURPLUS LINE MANUAL

In clarification of Excess Fidelity Bulletin No. 107, dated August 18, 1959, the Stamping Office and Contact Committee at its meeting held Tuesday, December 1, 1959 ruled as follows:

- 1. It is permissible to cancel Excess Fidelity written in a non-admitted insurer by a member and rewrite with another member.
- 2. One member may renew another member's Excess Fidelity coverage provided it has been written in a non-admitted insurer immediately preceding.
- 3. It is permissible to increase the amount of insurance under an Excess Fidelity certificate written in a non-admitted insurer by writing a new policy for the required additional amount.

Please be governed accordingly.
