Gentlemen:

In application for renewal of your Surplus Line License for the period commencing July 1, 1960 you listed as one of the insurers with which you place surplus line business the above insurer. We are advised that such insurer is owned, operated and controlled by the USSR. In view of the direct prohibition in Section 699.5 of the California Insurance Code against the admission of any insurer owned, operated or controlled directly or indirectly by any other nation or governmental subdivision or agency thereof, we believe that the public policy of this State as declared by the Legislature is that governmental owned and operated insurance enterprises should not be aided in the transaction of business by the California insurance business. We believe, therefore, that you should take appropriate steps to prevent risks placed by you in nonadmitted insurers from being placed in whole or in part in Black Sea and Baltic Insurance Company.
