BULLETIN TO ALL MEMBERS

RE: Breach of Warranty

The Stamping Office Committee, at its meeting on December 9, 1964, instructed the stamping office to issue this bulletin because the Committee felt that it contains useful information pertaining to the possible dangers that exist where certificates are written on a warranty basis, subject to the terms, conditions, etc., of an admitted carrier. Many cases have occurred in which the warranty company has made certain changes in its policy with the result that additional liability has been imposed on our certificates without the knowledge of the surplus line broker.

One of our prominent brokers assists his producer by supplying them with notices worded as follows:

I M P O R T A N T If any change is made in this policy immediate notice must be given to ---

(We suggest this notice be attached to the daily report of the Company used as Warranty.)
