Dear Sirs:

In order that surplus line brokers may be fully aware that an admitted insurer is willing to accept cast insurance on either a primary or excess basis, Fireman's Fund Insurance Company hereby notifies the Surplus Line Association that Fireman's Fund will and does provide a comprehensive market for cast insurance. Fireman's Fund will accept cast insurance either as a primary cover or as excess insurance or in combination.

As Fireman's Fund cannot forecast the precise divisions of insurance into layers or the exact policy provisions which may be adopted by ingenious brokers seeking an excuse for exportation, Fireman's Fund is not herein attempting to supply rate quotations. However, this will notify you that Fireman's Fund will accept any reasonable division of cast insurance and any reasonable policy coverage and is prepared upon receipt of your written request to supply your Association with its rates applicable to the particular insurance coverage.

Fireman's Fund is confident that the Surplus Line Association will not be a party to maneuvers designed to evade the provisions of the Surplus Line Law and we assure you that Fireman's Fund will cooperate with the Surplus Line Association in an effort to administer the Surplus Line Law in an equitable manner consistent with the spirit of the law itself.
