RE: Lloyd's Standardized Certificates

Underwriters at Lloyd's, London have embarked upon a program to standardize the certificate wordings used by their correspondent brokers throughout the United States to evidence risks placed through a Lloyd's contract authority or the open market.

The certificate forms were drafted by the Lloyd's Non-Marine Association in conjunction with Lloyd's United States General Counsel, LeBoeuf, Lamb, Leiby & MacRae. Specimen copies can be obtained from LeBoeuf, Lamb, Leiby & MacRae, One Embarcadero Center, Suite 611, San Francisco, CA 94111 (415) 951-1100.

Lloyd's does not require California brokers to utilize any one printer for the printing of the new forms. However, in order to ensure proper record keeping as respects the outflow of the new forms into the marketplace, Lloyd's does require that any printer of its forms adhere to certain guidelines.

Presently, CAL-TAB Systems in San Francisco (415-781-8129 - att: Carl H. Hansen) has been approved for the printing of Form SLC-3 California (for contract authority placements) and SLC-3 California OM (for open market placements). Eason Printing Company in Chicago (312-427-2926 - att: Jim Madden) has been approved for the printing of Form SLC-3 (USA) for states other than California. Any broker who wishes to use any other local or out-of-state printer should submit the name to LeBoeuf, Lamb, Leiby & MacRae so they can obtain Lloyd's approval.
