**RE: EXPORT LIST FOR CDL HEARING JULY 9, 1996**

### **WE NEED YOUR HELP!**

You have received Bulletin #764 advising you of the hearing on the creation of an export list which the CDI is conducting on July 9. Attached is the Export List that the The Surplus Line Association of California will be proposing at that hearing.


The List may not have everything on it that you wish. We were not able to include all the items that you told us should be on it. We have chosen the items that we believe we can evidence as there not being a "*reasonable or adequate market among admitted insurers.*" Keep in mind, that the Export List is simply a list of items that can be exported without conducting a *Diligent Search*. Types or Classes of business that are not on the List can *still be exported*, simply by conducting a diligent search.

We now need your help to make this Export List a reality.

- 1) You may feel that we have left out an item that should definitely be on the List. In that case, we urge you to participate in the aforementioned hearing, by either submitting written testimony or attending and offering verbal testimony.
- 2) Take a look at the list, fill in the columns and fax it back to us as soon as possible. Time is running short and we *desperately* need your feedback. It will not take you more than 5 minutes, but it is an important 5 minutes.
